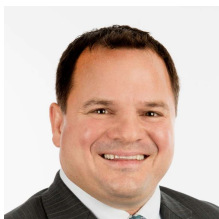

He also acted as CEO of Advanced Digital Broadcast and accompanied the successful IPO in 2005.

With a few friends, Philippe founded Cogito Instruments in 2016 to enable embedded machine intelligence. He believes that cognitive processing can and must happen inside machines. He also considers AI solutions in the cloud to be absolutely great for many applications. But when real-time interactions are needed, when constant availability is a must, or data must remain private & secure, Philippe prefers hardware-based neural solutions.
